Words from Nicola Coaker, Church Warden

This Sunday we are delighted to be joined by The Ven Dr Adrian Youings, Archdeacon of Bath. Archdeacon Adrian is a good friend of this parish and we are very grateful for his support and for the faith he showed in us when Fr Trevor left us 17mths ago. It is not in any way an exaggeration that we owe the appointment of Fr Brendan on a full time, 3 year interim ministry, to his intervention and support at Diocesan level. In reality, with the departure of Fr Trevor, our then size of congregation and Parish Share, we, like may parishes in the Diocese and beyond, would have been very fortunate to have been given a part time Priest, a .5 if you will. This has nothing to do with our history or tradition of worship but is a simple, hard truth. As it is, taking into account Stipend, Vicarage, size of Parish share and other factors, we as a Parish are being 'subbed' by the Diocese to the tune of over £50k a year.

That said, we have come a very long way in addressing the challenges agreed with the PCC and Archdeacon Adrian in returning to our place as the 'Town Church'. Our Lower Hall facilities are nearly complete, and partnerships nurtured to deliver a ministry of hospitality to our Parish and beyond and its use as a centre of community. We have strengthened links with the school and welcome them regularly to our Church and vice versa and have two, soon to be three, parishioners serving as Foundation Governors. Work with young people has begun with our Easter, Christmas and School holiday activities and we continue to work towards a vision of how Church in the School can work post covid. Clevedon Choral society has returned to St John's which is now their home church along with exhibitions from North Somerset Art Society (another one is planned for a few months' time). The exciting plans for our weeklong Patronal Festival in May which will include concerts, cinema, and a Betjeman evening. Our Church is open daily for Mass, the congregation size doubled, and the Vicarage is always open where the parish and visitors alike have enjoyed the generous hospitality afforded there and there are many more reasons for hope and optimism in our missionary journey.

We are nearly half way through the interim ministry period and cannot take for granted that this will continue beyond the allotted time but we can build on the work we as a Parish have done in our community in sharing the Gospel. So, this Sunday let's thank Archdeacon Adrian for his commitment to our Parish and its mission as the 'Town Church'. Nicola.


Ukrainian Unity Day
